HOW TO HANDLE EMERGENCY

- Talk your way out of the situation
- If you need to unbuckle seat belt ask first
- Do not resist unless you know that such will lead to escape
- Do not panic
- In a robbery do as you are told
- Keep your hands still and see able
- Drink a lot of water regularly
- Avoid swimming in rivers before inquiring whether its safe
- Dress light due to high temperatures
- Protect your skin from exposure to UVA rays
- Mosquito repellent is a must pack.

WHEN DRIVING

- if possible avoid travelling at night or in remote areas
- try always to park in a busy well lit place
- do not ever stop to pick up a hitch hiker
- always drive with doors closed
- never seat on top of vehicle while on game drive
- do not leave any valuables in the car
- keep with the speed limits
- familiarise yourself with local ordinances remember Uganda is keep left when driving

VISITING LOCAL TOWNS

- its advised that you only visit with the aid of your tour guide/driver
- keep large amounts of money, cameras, jewellery and mobile phones out of sight
- its allowed to haggle for an item in a market.

CRIME

- take reasonable care thou crime is very trivial in Uganda
- do not flash your credit card any how keep it in safe place
- keep close eye on your belongings and hold to them in public place
- avoid dark places at night

- arrange to be picked in case you are out lone
- use only recognised car or office taxi ,, - avoid the use of ATM in night.
- Always keep yourself informed in case of political unrest just in case it happens.
- Always ask for tourism police number from your tour guide or driver Uganda has put in place a
- tourism police desk.
- do not move alone on trials
- move in a group or with your guide

LOST OR STOLEN CELL PHONE

- make aware the loss of your cell phone with mobile service provider MTN, AIRTEL
- report the loss of you cell phone to nearest police station
- always have the contact of your bank, credit card company in case of lost or stolen

ON THE STREETS

- traffic officer or police officer will be very helpful to direct you.
- do not expose jewellery, mobile phones
- plan your route
- keep your bags zipped always
- exchange your money at the bank

AT HOTEL OR OTHER ACCOMODATION

- make sure that luggage is handled by bell boy
- hand in you room key at reception will moving out
- keep your room locked
- in case one knocks on your room check before opening
- make use of safety deposit box in the room
- report any suspicious parcels at reception
- never swim alone without lifeguard on site

AT AIRPORT

- keep your luggage with you
- when asking for directions use only marked information booths
- do not allow people to tamper with you bags

- Communicate with your driver.


